Subject: **Assessment Arrangement Update**

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We are writing to provide updated information about the assessment arrangement in response to the COVID-19 outbreak. Our overriding priority is to ensure that you have the teaching and learning opportunities to ensure that you achieve the outcomes of the course and much more is going on to develop new methods of delivering assessment.

For the remaining Semester 1 courses and Semester 2 courses, the examinations will be scheduled in an extended period from **18 May 2020 to 19 June 2020**. The assessment methods of these courses will be **revised/adjusted** as deemed appropriate. The revised/adjusted assessment arrangement, after obtaining approval by relevant Committee, will be announced by respective Schools/Departments. As mentioned earlier in the circular dated 24 February 2020, about **3 weeks of revision** will be provided for students before the examinations. The details of the arrangement concerned will be again announced by the respective Schools/Departments in due course. Please be reassured that we will do everything we can to ensure that you are not disadvantaged by the difficult situation we face.

Another email will be sent to all students in late April/early May 2020, providing with the **examination timetable** and more details about the examination arrangement. To enable part-time students to plan ahead, following our current practice, the examination of their courses will be scheduled in accordance with the weekly lecture time whenever possible.

We appreciate that this is a challenging time for all, and we hope that you are able to take good care of yourself and each other. Support remains available to you via your respective Schools/Departments as well as the non-academic units.
